task.

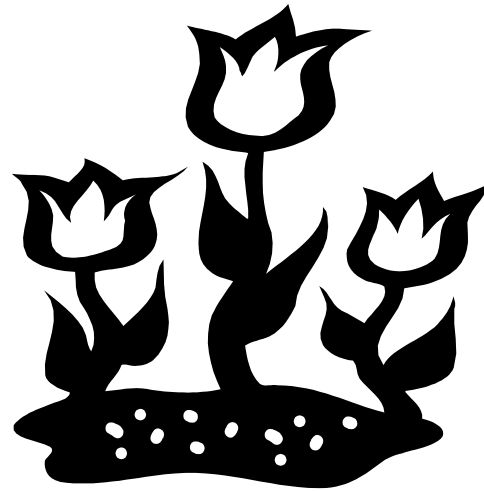
You're a dependable source of
